The Hong Kong Education Bureau (HK-EDB) implemented the Native-speaking English Teacher (NET) Scheme to expose students to the English language and enhance the overall teaching experience. Since the 2002/03 school year, NETs have been placed in primary and secondary public schools throughout Hong Kong. Since implementation, the program has been one of the most successful of its kind in the world.
